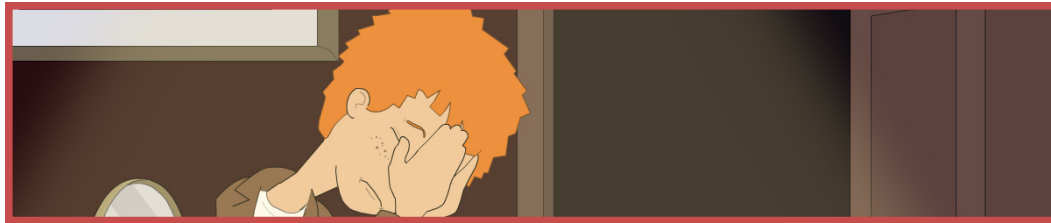


Edifying Stories for the whole family

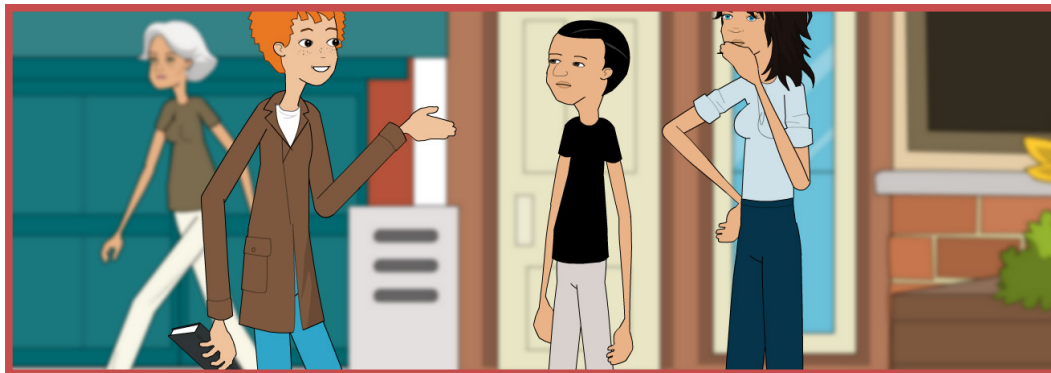
A mother's last prayer.

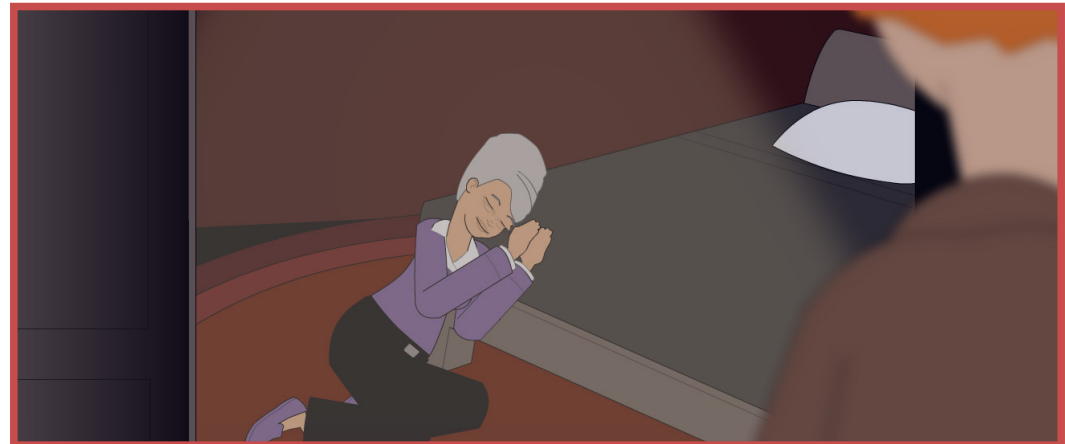
As he walked out the door, his mother called after him, "Peter, you know I'll be praying for you until you come back!"
